Yes, we are truly thankful for your help, and for God's grace which has changed lives for the better.

But there is more work to be done. Our mission is nothing less than to build a culture where life, marriage and family can thrive.

Let me share with you one of the things that breaks my heart.

Pornography use and sexual addictions have taken hold of society, tearing apart marriages and destroying the capacity of even faith-filled people to truly love. Pornography uses another person as an object for one's own selfish sexual pleasure. It denies their human dignity. Victims are the vulnerable: children, babies, young women and men who are insecure. At work, at home, in our secondary schools (yes, even in our Catholic Colleges), people are trading pornographic images for their own erotic pleasure. Pope Saint John Paul II wrote that the opposite of love is not hate, but use. God never created his children to use one another.¹


Pornography's effects on brain chemistry, along with its ability to ease emotional pain, are what make it highly addictive. Hardcore pornography, easily accessible on the internet, can have the same highly addictive effect on the brain as crack cocaine.2 Once an image is seen, it cannot be unseen. Men especially, can become hooked through a single exposure, whether this was intentional or accidental.



We must expose pornography as a highly destructive force, safeguard families and marriages from the ravages of this plague, and help men and women harmed by it to find healing. Currently, families are forced to seek help from overseas experts, paying thousands of dollars in their desperate need for healing. I cannot sit by and not offer help.

Here's what the John Paul II Centre for Life is planning for next year

- Small coaching groups for women who have been deeply wounded by their spouse's betrayal of their marriage through use of pornography, sexual chatlines, etc
- Groups for men who want to break free from their sexual addictions
- Free phone/online counselling for youth who are starting to realise the great harm they have done to their own and others' mental and emotional health through sexting and porn use
- Experts to train priests throughout NZ in how to help men and women in the confessional, and face to face (already approved by the NZ Bishops' Conference)
- Workshops for parents, giving them tools to keep their children safe while using the internet and other resources
- Learning sessions for children, encompassing the beauty of the human person made in God's image, and how they can protect themselves from abuse
- All that in addition to the other valuable services. we offer, including marriage preparation and enrichment, support with painful life challenges such as infertility, adverse prenatal diagnosis, miscarriage, and post abortion healing



You have trusted us in the past to work with pregnant mothers and women broken by abortion.

Will you now help us to restore people, marriages and families broken by pornography?
